



Triangle Farms Rules & Procedures 3301 Silver Water Lane, Wake Forest, NC 27587 Barn Hours ~ Closed Monday Winter Hours: Tuesday – Sunday 10am – 6pm Summer Hours: Tuesday – Sunday 9am – 7pm Barn hours for Holidays and Horse Shows may be adjusted.

- Riders must wear riding boots and a properly fitted, certified SEI/ASTM safety approved helmet, with the harness fastened, while mounted.
- Boarder parking is provided to the right side of the barn.
- Riders may not carry or use cell phones while mounted.
- Lessons/training have ring priority. No lunging is allowed in the Show Ring or in either ring while others are riding. Jumping is not allowed unless with the instructor in the ring. Only the instructor and farm employees are allowed in the ring during lessons. Ring gates must be closed/latched while riding.
- Riding alone, either on the farm or off the farm, is not allowed.
- Horses are turned out each day, weather permitting. Single turnout, if required, is an additional fee.
- Riders are expected to take two lessons/week or a combination of two lessons and/or training riders per week.
- The feed room, owner's tack room, hay/shavings storage area and medicine cabinets are for employee use only.
- Boarders are expected to do their horse's laundry, to include saddle pads and wraps. Barn employees will wash/dry the towels used in the wash rack.
- Shampoo, fly spray, hoof oil, towels are provided in wash rack/grooming stall.
- Riders are expected to clean up after themselves and their horses and to leave the wash rack, grooming stall and barn aisle clean.
- Boarder's saddle, bridle, helmet and brush box are to be stored in the Boarder Tack Room. Boarders are provided a tack box by Triangle Farms, to be stored in a cubby in the Tack Room. Other tack & supplies are to be stored in the rider's tack trunk in the designated area.
- If brought to the barn, a rider's dog must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Children under 16 must be supervised by a parent/authorized adult.
- Only farm management, employees, vets, farriers, horse owners/lessees and students enrolled in lessons may enter the stalls.
