\$2500 Triangle Farms Derby Finals Specs

Open to non-professional riders on horses or ponies showing at the show. Two Derbies to be held, Wee Derby

Finals & Amateur Derby Finals, each Derby to award \$1250 prize money & \$100 to each Derby winner's trainer. Ribbons. awards & prize money to be awarded to the top 12 riders. Triangle Farms Derby Finals to be run using the Hunt and Go Format. The Derby consists of two phases, the Classic Hunter and the Handy Hunter, jumped consecutively in one round. The Classic Hunter Round, consisting of 7-8 fences with 2 high options, to be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. After the completion of the Classic portion, horses pass through a set of markers to begin the Handy portion of the Derby. The Handy Hunter Round, consisting of 5-6 fences with 2 high options, to be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Brilliance and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Two scores to be given, one for the Classic Round and one for the Handy Round. Bonus points of one point per high option jump to be added, total score to be total of Classic Round, Handy Round and High Options.

Short Stirrup Hunter, Pony Hunter, Children's Hunter, Adult Amateur Hunter, Jr/Am Hunter, Low Ch/Ad Hunter, Beginner Crossrails, Long Stirrup, Age Group Eq, NCHJA Equitation Medals, and Ch/Ad Jumpers are run in accordance with NCHJA and SCHJA rules. Walk Trot is open to beginner riders; may not cross enter into any other division. Beginner Crossrails is open to riders in their first 2 years of showing; may not cross enter into any other division. Long Stirrup is open to riders over 12 years of age. Pre-Green Hunter is open to horses in their first 2 years of showing. Green Hunter is open to horses who have not shown over fences exceeding 3' at NCHJA or USEF shows. Schooling, Low, Hopeful, Modified, Open and Special are open to all horses and riders. High and Low Warm Ups on Friday are open to Derby Finals Riders Only.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of South Carolina Hunter Jumper Association ("SCHJA") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a SCHJA sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities ("SCHJA Event(s)"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS**: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of SCHJA, which are available at www.schja.org/rules.html, as amended from time to time.

- B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any SCHJA Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the SCHJA Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks"). EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING: CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK. Under the laws of South Carolina and neighboring states, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
- C. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK**: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the SCHJA Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any SCHJA Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any SCHJA Event.
- D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any SCHJA Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: SCHJA, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any SCHJA Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the SCHJA Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a SCHJA Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the SCHJA Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.
- E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason

unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any SCHJA Event. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim. The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) is aware of the many obvious and non-obvious risks associated with a horse show and does hereby release and hold harmless Triangle Farms, Inc. and its affiliates, including its shareholders, agents, employees, officers, directors, representatives, assigns, affiliated organizations (whether nonprofit or for profit), boarders, exhibitors, sponsors, students, lessors, lessees, insurers and others acting on behalf of any of them (collectively, "Triangle Farms") from all claims, demands, causes of action and legal liability related to the Horse Show Participant's participation in or presence during the Horse Show, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, foreseeable or unforeseeable, and even if such are the result of the negligence and/or acts or omissions of Triangle Farms or other Horse Show Participants or other individuals or animals present during the Horse Show.

Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) further agrees to (a) waive all claims which may otherwise arise from an injury to a Horse Show Participant or other individual or animal associated with Horse Show Participant while using or being present at the Horse Show, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection (including, but not limited to, the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19 and other rhino or coronaviruses as well as rabies, hepatitis, pneumonia and meningitis-causing viruses, among others; bacteria commonly known as tetanus, Salmonella, E. Coli, Staphylococcus, Streptococcus and tuberculosis, among others; fungus commonly known as Candida (yeast), aspergillus (mold) and ringworm, among others; various parasitic organisms such as giardia, pinworm, toxoplasma, hookworm, tapeworm, roundworm, scabies, among others, and all other infectious agents) in humans, including Participant, as well as in animals; and (b) not pursue any claims, demands or causes of action against Triangle Farms for any economic or non-economic losses arising out of the Horse Show which are the result of any bodily injury, death or property damage suffered by a Horse Show Participant or any other individuals or animals associated with Horse Show Participant and present at the Horse Show.
